10 Days, 2 Whales

The eyes of the nation were on Maugherow earlier this month as two fin whales were washed up on beaches near Raghly. Although always a sad event, these beached mammals, at 40ft and 60ft in length, were quite something to behold and visitors came from all over the country to get a look.

A few years ago, the people of Kilbrittan in Co. Cork created a popular tourist attraction by reassembling the skeleton of a beached whale and putting on display in the village park. And now the residents of Maugherow have embarked on a similar project.

On Saturday 10th December, a group of local volunteers came together and despite near freezing conditions managed to transport one of the whales to Raghly harbour, where the blubber and meat was removed and disposed of.

Each bone of the carcass was then sorted and meticulously labelled. The bones will now be entombed for several months (in horse manure) to allow nature do its thing. Then all going well, Maugherow and North Sligo may become home to yet another 'must see' tourist attraction. (Well done to all involved!).
