Do One Thing...

If you do one thing this New Year, check your smoke alarms! Approx 46 people die in Ireland in fires each year. And following the recent tragedies in Gurteen and Boyle, there's a need to increase peoples' awareness and knowledge of fire safety and prevention in the home.



To test your alarm, push and hold the test button for a few seconds. The detector should produce a loud noise. If it doesn't, change the batteries or get a new one.

So lets up our game this year...

- Install working smoke and carbon monoxide detectors and test them regularly (do it right now!)
- Make a fire escape plan and practice it often
- Check for fire dangers in your home and correct them
- Carry out a 'last thing at night routine'
