Check It Now...

If you do one thing this month, check your smoke alarms. Approx 46 people die in Ireland in fires each year. Checking your smoke alarms right now will only take a few seconds, but it might save your life!



To test your alarm, push and hold the test button for a few seconds. The detector should produce a loud noise. If it doesn't, change the batteries or get a new one.

Fire Safety Tips...

- Install working smoke and carbon monoxide detectors and test them regularly (do it right now!)
- Make a fire escape plan and practice it often
- <u>Check</u> for fire dangers in your home and correct them
- <u>Carry out</u> a 'last thing at night routine'
