Oxfield Secures Leader Funding...

A start to Phase 1 of the Oxfield Community Centre redevelopment project is now just a few weeks away following full approval of our recent application to Sligo Leader for grant aid assistance. The Phase 1 project involves the replacement of the main hall roof, a new heating system for the hall, a new fire detection system, solar panels, and re-tiling of the ladies toilets.
