The Supreme Court has ruled that there are no rights of way around Lissadell House and through the estate inferred from decades of public use, except for the section of the avenue that accesses the coast. It is unclear what will now happen to Lissadell House which was bought in 2003 for approx €4m. A hearing to decide on costs will be held at a later date, but is likely to see the County Council facing a substantial bill.
