Oxfield 500 Club...

The first major fundraiser for the Oxfield Centre in over 11 years kicks off later this month in the form of a 500 Club monthly draw with 66 prizes, including over €22,000 'CASH' in prize money.



The draw aims to raise 25% matching funding for proposed grant applications for a long overdue new insulated roof and new heating system for the existing Oxfield Centre which will benefit everyone in the community.



There will be monthly cash prizes of $\notin 500, \notin 200, \notin 100(x3)$, a grand prize of $\notin 10,000$ in the 12^{th} month, plus there will be a series of other spot prizes every second month, ranging from a family holiday in Marbella to an iPad2.

Tickets will cost €10 per month (or €100 up front) which equates to as little as €8.33 per month or €1.92 per week (based on the €100 option). Flyers will be delivered across the area shortly and our volunteers will be on the roads towards the end of October and early November looking for your support!
